
Burial Rites

St. Paul's Memorial Garden – Proclaiming our Resurrection Faith

St. Paul's Memorial Garden is situated in the wooded area behind our Chapel, surrounded by redbuds, dogwoods, azaleas, hollies and gardenias. It is within this beautiful setting that the ashes of St. Paul's parishioners, former parishioners and extended family, are laid to rest. Ashes can be buried in grass-covered plots, with the corresponding names being engraved in the Garden's Memorial Markers. Alternatively, ashes may be placed within the adjoining Columbarium. Two Remembrance Walls are available for engraving the names of relatives and friends whose remains reside elsewhere. Benches and a water feature provide a peaceful and contemplative setting for visitors of the Garden.

Interment in Garden



St. Paul's Memorial Garden was dedicated in 1994. The Garden features 1 ft-by-1 ft grass-covered plots and granite markers. Plots currently may be purchased for \$1,000 which includes engraving the name of the interred on a marker.

Inurnment in Columbarium



In 2014, a Columbarium was added to the Memorial Garden, allowing inurnment of ashes in above-ground niches. A granite faceplate indicates who is inurned in each niche. The fee for a one- or two-person niche, including urns and engraving, currently is \$2,500.

Remembrance Wall



Adjoining the Columbarium and Garden are two Remembrance Walls. The name of a relative or friend currently can be engraved in one of the walls for \$300.
